



Team Award

Description

This award recognizes a group or committee that has made a significant contribution toward achieving ENA's mission to advance excellence in emergency care through the development of a sustainable project or program.

Requirements

- Self-nominations are allowed.
 - If self-nominating, nominator / nominee must be an ENA member
- If nominating someone else, one Team member must be an ENA member
- Two narrative statements (each addressing three separate criteria listed below) written by two different individuals. One narrative must be written by the Nominator.
- CV / Resume summary of the ENA member on the Team (please see page 2 in the Achievement Awards Handbook for a list of specific information needed).

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Please do not include the name of the Team or any identifying information in the narrative statements.

- Each response must be limited to a maximum of 200 words.
- Develop responses in a word processing program such as Microsoft Word, use the WORD COUNT checker to ensure your responses are limited to 200 words, as well as the spell-check option. Then copy and paste responses into the online nomination form.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

1. A description of the Team's project or program that has made a positive impact on the profession of emergency nursing or patients.
2. A description of how the Team's project or program will be sustained and will affect a community, regional, national or international initiative.
3. A description of how the Team's project or program has made a significant contribution toward achieving ENA's mission to advance excellence in emergency nursing.
