



2010 Educational Scholarship Opportunities

Welcome to the ENA Foundation scholarship program. The ENA Foundation was established in 1991 by the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). The mission of the foundation is to provide educational scholarships and research grants in the discipline of emergency nursing. You may locate a copy of the application in Word format from the ENA Web site at www.ena.org, click on the Foundation tab and search under scholarships. Eligibility requirements for ALL scholarships:

- Applicants must be an ENA member for a minimum of twelve (12) months immediately prior to applying. Non-RN category applicants are not required to be an ENA member but a letter of reference from a current ENA member is required.
- A minimum of a 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) is required for consideration.
- Applicants must be attending a NLN or AACN accredited school and must provide verification of the schools current accreditation.
- Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply under the same category. However, qualified previous recipients may apply for the next category.
- ENA members having served in the immediate past three years on the ENA Board of Directors, ENA Foundation Board of Trustees, or ENA Foundation Scholarship Review Team are ineligible to apply.

Application Guidelines:

- Handwritten or hand-printed applications are not accepted.
- Applications must be mailed or e-mailed. Faxed applications are not acceptable.
- Applications submitted electronically must include scanned copies of the required documents: signed copy of application, transcripts, references letters, etc.
- Affix only paper clips or binder clips. Do not use staples.
- All blanks must be filled in. Do not include a CV or resume. Attaching a CV or resume in place of filling in blanks is not acceptable.
- Applicants may only apply under one category and only one application per category is allowed.

Application Review Process: Applications will be reviewed by the ENA Foundation review panel, who are all members of the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). Including the total points awarded for each section, applicants may earn up to 100 points; an overall score of 80 or more is necessary to receive an award. The criteria for determining awards are as follows,

- A maximum of 45 points can be awarded to the applicant's Statement of Professional/Educational goals for clarity and content. This statement is limited to one page and must include goals directly related to emergency nursing.
- A maximum of 35 points can be awarded to the applicant's professional association involvement. depending on the award, applicant must be either be a member of ENA, National Student Nursing Association (NSNA) or a state/national EMT, firefighter or police officer association to apply for a scholarship. Please note, membership is a minimal requirement; the review panel will be looking for evidence of active involvement such as work on committees, meeting attendance, teaching in organizations-sponsored events, attending conferences, etc.
- A maximum of 10 points will be given for the presentation of the application. Included in this area are the form of the application; its readability; coherence between sections; consistency between the goal statement and professional activity; and the spelling, syntax and grammar of all narrative portions of the application.
- A maximum of 10 points will be given for the quality of reference letters submitted with your application.
