The Nurse in Washington Internship program provides nurses the opportunity to learn how to influence health care through the legislative process. Participants learn from a distinguished faculty of health policy experts and government officials, many of whom are nurses. NIWI highlights include opportunities to network with other nurses, an Executive Branch briefing, and visits to Members of Congress.

This four-day learning experience will energize and prepare attendees to become actively involved in the health policy process at the local, state or national levels. The Internship, in its 20th year, culminates with a day on Capitol Hill, when participants visit their legislators to discuss topics and issues of concern to them.
