



Crisis Response Team Award

Description

This award recognizes an emergency department healthcare team who has risen above-and-beyond to achieve ENA's mission by responding to the challenges of working during a crisis situation (natural or man-made disasters; public health crises).

ENA's Mission Statement

The mission of the Emergency Nurses Association is to advance excellence in emergency nursing.

Requirements

- Self-nominations are allowed
- At least one team member must be an ENA member
- Two narrative statements from two different individuals addressing the four separate criteria listed below. At least one narrative must be written by an ENA member
- Curriculum vitae / Resume summary of an ENA member on the Team (please see the Achievement Awards Handbook on the Awards webpage for a list of specific information needed)

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Narrative statements should not include the name of the Team.

Each response has a word count limit of 200 words.

Use of bullet point responses is encouraged.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

1. A description of how the Team used innovative ideas and practices to make positive impacts on patients, patients' families, or staff in response to the crisis situation.
2. A description of how the Team demonstrated advocacy for patients, or patients' families' well-being.
3. A description of how members of the Team implemented well-being initiatives to promote and support self-care.
4. A description of evidence-based resources (external, internal, unique educational tools, pre-existing resources/education materials) utilized to communicate an educational plan to patients, patients' families, or staff to increase safety and awareness of the crisis situation. For example: in-services, computer-based training, handouts, etc.
