

Nurse Manager Award

Description

This award recognizes a nurse in an emergency nursing management role who has consistently demonstrated excellence in the profession of emergency nursing and has made significant contributions.

Requirements

- Nominee must be an ENA member.
- Nominator must be an ENA member.
- Two narrative statements (addressing five separate criteria listed below) written by two different individuals who are supervised by the Nominee. One narrative must be written by the Nominator.
- CV / Resume summary of the Nominee (please see page 2 in the Achievement Awards Handbook for a list of specific information needed).

To save time in preparing for EN24: in case your nominee receives the award, if possible, please email the nominee's current headshot photo, 8x10, high resolution/300 dpi (no iPhone/smartphone photos) to AnnualAwards@ena.org. However, this is not mandatory.

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Please do not include the name of the nominee in the narrative statements.

- o Each response must be limited to a maximum of 200 words.
- Develop responses in a word processing program such as Microsoft Word, use the WORD COUNT checker to ensure your responses are limited to 200 words, as well as the spell-check option. Then copy and paste responses into the online nomination form.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

- 1. A description of how the nominee demonstrates professional characteristics of an emergency nurse while collaborating with colleagues in the work setting for a minimum of three years.
- 2. A description of how the nominee encourages professional development through role modeling, mentoring and leadership skills.
- 3. A description of the creative solutions to tough management decisions or program development that have benefitted the staff reporting to the nominee.
- 4. A summary of the specific situations where the nominee has served as a consultant or resource on emergency nursing issues either within the emergency care setting or within the organization, or at the state or national level (i.e., working with the licensing board).
- 5. A description of how the supervised staff regards the nominee with respect and as an effective manager.
