



Rising Star Award

Description

This award recognizes a new ENA member (membership fewer than five years) who has made a significant contribution to ENA as exhibited by promotion of ENA as the professional organization for emergency nurses at the local, state, or national level.

Requirements

- Nominee must be a new ENA member (fewer than five years from the date of nomination)
- One narrative statement from the nominee's State or Chapter President addressing the three separate criteria listed below
- Curriculum vitae / Resume summary of the Nominee (please see the Achievement Awards Handbook for a list of specific information needed)

Narrative Statement / Criteria

Narrative statements should not include the name of the nominee.

The narrative statement should address each criterion listed below:

1. A description of the high level of enthusiastic engagement demonstrated by the nominee as an ENA member through the promotion of membership, program participation or educational role modeling for professional colleagues
2. A description of the nominee's actions that have resulted in significant contributions to ENA at the local, state, or national level
3. A description of how the nominee has actively supported ENA's mission and readily shares his/her knowledge and expertise with others
