

### How do I join ENA online?

Click on the “Join” icon located on the top right banner of the ENA website. Follow instructions to create an account with ENA. Once an account is created, click on the “Join” icon one more time to begin the process and find the membership option that is right for you.

### How do I reset my password?

1. Log in to the ENA membership portal via the “Login” icon located on the top right banner of the ENA website.
2. In your member profile, select “Security & Login” link.
3. Enter your current and new password. Your password must be at least eight characters long, have a mix of letters and numbers, and cannot contain your username.
4. Once you click “Submit,” your login information will be updated. A confirmation email will be sent to your primary email address.

### Does ENA offer flexible payment options?

### Can I set my ENA membership to automatically renew?

### How do I update my credit card information for AutoRenew or Installment Payments?

1. Log in to the ENA membership portal via the “Login” icon located on the top right banner of the ENA website.
2. In your member profile, click on the “My Scheduled Payments” link to review your information.
3. To update payment information, click on the three dots and select “Edit.”
4. Click on the “Add Stored Payment Method” link to add a new card on file.
5. Click “Save.”
6. Click “Update.”

### How do I access the *Journal of Emergency Nursing* online?

As a new member of ENA or if this is your first-time accessing the Journal online, you must complete these steps:

#### Step 1: Register for a free account.

1. Click on the “Menu” icon at the top right of the screen.
2. Select “Publications.”
3. Select the “*Journal of Emergency Nursing* (JEN)” option.
4. Click on “Access JEN Online” button.
5. On the *Journal of Emergency Nursing* page, click on the “Register” icon at the top right of the screen.
6. Complete the “Create a Free Account” form.

#### Step 2: Claim your *Journal of Emergency Nursing* subscription.

1. Once registered, click on the “Login” icon. Your login credentials are your registered email address and password.
2. Post login, your name will be displayed at the top right of the screen.
3. Click on the “Claim” icon to initiate a one-time claim process.
4. Tick the checkbox that says, “I receive my subscription through a society membership” and select the Society name “Emergency Nurses Association (ENA).”
5. Enter your ENA Member ID in the “Account Number” field, and Last Name in the “Last Name” field.
6. Click “Activate Claim.”
7. You will receive a “Claim Activation Successful” message and thereby your claiming process is complete.
8. Click on your name link at the top right of the screen and select “My Access” from the drop-down menu.
