

ANCC/ENA CNE Updates

(Effective December 22, 2015)

ANCC Criteria Updates

- ❖ Sponsorship agreements will no longer be required. (Sponsorship is financial or in-kind contributions from an organization that does not fit the category of a commercial interest and that are used to pay for all or part of the costs of a CNE activity.) The Commercial Support Agreement is still required when applicable.
- ❖ Requirement for objectives at the individual activity level has been removed
 - *Note: Objectives at the individual activity level may still be used if desired however they will not be required by ANCC.*
- ❖ The requirement that the ANCC accreditation/approval statement stand on its own line of text has been removed.
- ❖ Purpose has been revised to learning outcome

ENA Updates

- ❖ The role of the Activity Coordinator has been removed. The Nurse Planner serves as the primary liaison between the provider submitting the application and the ENA Approver Unit. A Point of Contact can also be listed on the application for correspondence related to the application.
