When and where is Emergency Nursing 2021?

Is there a cancellation policy?

Yes. Requests for cancellations/refunds must be submitted in writing on or before Aug 6 by emailing enaen@csreg.zohodesk.com. All requests are subject to a \$50 administrative fee. Refunds will be processed in the name of the original payer within 60 days after the initial request is received. All conference registrations are non-transferable. Refunds are not given after Aug. 6, and ENA will not reimburse you if you do not attend.

Non-receipt of a confirmation notice before the meeting is not justification for seeking a refund. If you wish to defer your registration payment to Emergency Nursing 2022, it must be submitted in writing on or before Aug. 6. Deferred registrations will not be eligible for refunds later. Emergency Nursing 2021 registrants who are approved for a deferral request will be allowed to defer for only one year. The refund and cancellation policy will not be waived.
