Thank you for your interest in the ENA Foundation conference scholarship program. The mission of the ENA Foundation is to provide educational scholarships and research grants in the discipline of emergency nursing.

The 2019 Conference Scholarship for International ENA Members will provide funding for recipients to attend ENA's Annual Conference (EN19) in 2019. The conference will take place in Austin, Texas on September 29 – October 2, 2019. International Conference Scholarship will provide funding for registration to EN19 and 1-5 nights hotel (based on need).

Eligibility Requirements for International Scholarships

- Applicants must be an ENA member in good standing
- Applicants must live and work in a country outside the United States
- Previous conference scholarship recipients are not eligible to reapply
- Members already receiving funding from national associations, state councils or chapters are ineligible
- ENA members having served in the immediate past three years on the ENA board of directors, ENA Foundation board of trustees, or the ENA Foundation scholarship selection committee are ineligible to apply.

Application Criteria and Notification

Due to the volume of applications received and available funding, only a select number of applicants will receive awards waiving their conference registration fee of \$520 and (1-5 nights) hotel stay. All applicants will be notified of selection via email by April 30th. Recipients are responsible for covering airfare and visa fees. **It is the responsibility of the recipient to arrange necessary visa as applicable.**

Candidates who are not selected will still have until July 31 to register for the Annual Conference at the early-bird registration rate of \$520, after which the registration cost will increase to \$750.

The application does not require any specific documents. Be prepared to provide the following information: Member number, join date; previous attendance at an ENA conference; participation as Conference faculty; and statements explaining how you will benefit from attending the Conference and your financial need for a scholarship.
