- Exemplary ED Recognition Work Team
- 5-year development (2005-2010)
- Statistician analysis
- Application timeline: Mid-November → late February
- Fee \$3000

# What Will Stay the Same?

- Focus on excellence in 5 domains:
  - Leadership-Practice
  - Leadership-Operations
  - Education
  - Advocacy
  - Research/Practice
- Application timeline (November February)
- Quality metrics (national benchmarks)
- Award recognition period (3 years)



#### What Will Be Different?

- New requirement: AACN Healthy Work Environment Assessment Tool
  - Validated tool based on six HWE standards
  - Complete <u>prior</u> to submitting Lantern application
  - Enter HWEAT "aggregate score" in application
  - Participant rate also scored
  - Random audit process (5% of all recipients)

## **How To Implement the HWEAT**

- 1) Point of contact creates an account on AACN website: AACN Healthy Work Environment Assessment Tool
- 2) Select the "Team" version of the survey
- 3) Send the HWE survey to ED staff
- 4) Download your Team Results report



#### What Will Be Different?

- New topics: Triage, pediatric readiness, behavioral health
- Reduction in questions
  - Overall questions: 83 → 69
  - Narratives and exemplars: 38 → 29
  - Only one assigned staff RN exemplar; no physician exemplar
- Lantern Award resource materials and branding
- Application fee \$3500
