- Originally the Emergency Department Nurses Association (EDNA)
- Founded in 1970 by Anita Dorr and Judith Kelleher
- In 1985, name was changed to Emergency Nurses Association (ENA)
- Grown into the largest voluntary association dedicated to the education and support of emergency nurses
- Legacy continues through ENA's mission to advocate for patient safety and excellence in emergency nursing practice




