Crisis Response Team Award

Description

This award recognizes an emergency department health care team who has risen above-and-beyond to achieve ENA's mission to lead the advancement of excellence and innovation in emergency nursing through research, education, resources, advocacy, and collaboration by responding to the challenges of working during a crisis situation, such as public health crisis or natural or man-made disasters.

Award Requirements

- Self-nominations are allowed
 - If nominating your Team, the nominator must be an ENA member and nurse practicing in an emergency care setting
- If nominating someone else, one member of that Team must be an ENA member and nurse practicing in an emergency care setting
- Two narrative statements (each addressing four separate criteria listed below) written by two different individuals. One narrative must be written by the Nominator
- CV / Resume summary of the Team's ENA Member (please see pages 2 and 3 in the [Achievement Awards Handbook](#) for a list of specific information needed).

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Please do not include the name of the Team or any identifying information in the narrative statements.

- Each response must be limited to a maximum of 200 words.
 - Develop responses in a word processing program such as Microsoft Word, use the WORD COUNT checker to ensure your responses are limited to 200 words, as well as the spell-check option. Then copy and paste responses into the online nomination form.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

1. Provide specific example(s) of how the Team used innovative ideas and practices to make positive impacts on patients, patients' families, or staff in response to the crisis situation.
2. Provide specific example(s) of how the Team demonstrated collaborative advocacy for the well-being of patients, or patients' families.
3. Provide specific example(s) of how members of the Team implemented well-being/healthy work environment initiatives to promote and support self-care.
4. Provide specific example(s) of evidence-based resources (external, internal, unique educational tools, pre-existing resources/education materials) utilized to communicate an educational plan for staff and community preparedness to increase safety and awareness of the crisis situation. For example: in-services, computer-based training, handouts, etc.
